



The project consists of the rehabilitation of the existing Lake Mead State Fish Hatchery located at 245 Lakeshore Road in Clark County, Nevada. The rehabilitation consists of the demolition of the existing rearing ponds which had been constructed in the 1970's and which exhibited concrete deterioration and the construction of two new rearing buildings, two storage buildings, five residences for National Park Service employees, and a asphalt paved access road. The construction cost was estimated at 4.1 million dollars. GES performed a design level geotechnical investigation for the project which included recommendations to fill an approximately 30-foot deep canyon where the new storage buildings were to be constructed and percolation tests to help site a leach field for the new residences.

Currently, during construction which is nearly complete, GES provided construction services including the inspection and testing of soil, reinforcing steel, concrete, high strength bolts and welding, and asphalt.
