

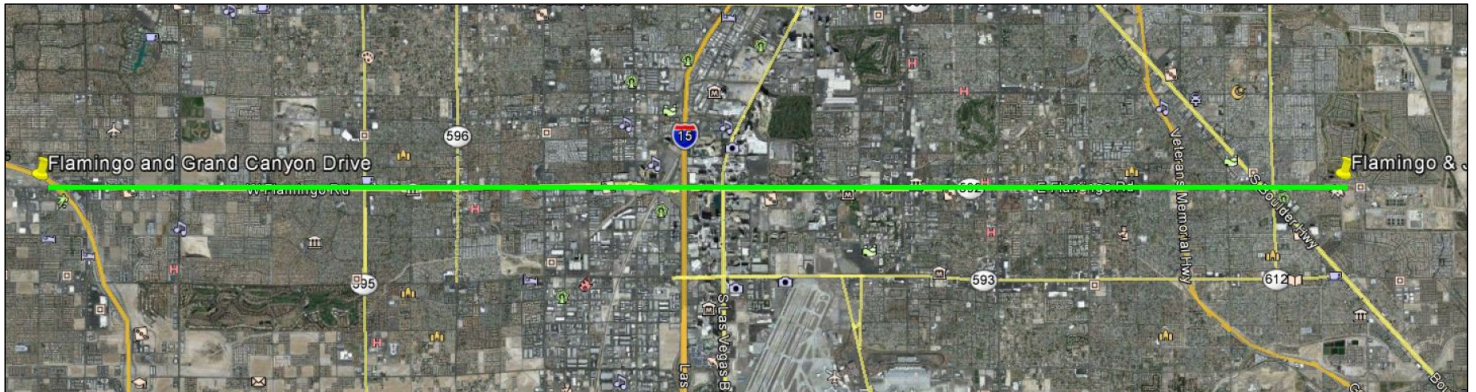
FLAMINGO CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION LAS VEGAS, NV



The project consists of the improvements to a 14-mile transit corridor improvements from Grand Canyon Dr. to Jimmy Durante Blvd.; connection to 15 transit routes, including 11 residential, 3 express routes (Strip & Downtown Express, Centennial Express, Boulder Highway Express) and the Deuce on the Strip; dedicated bus/bike lanes; bus will operate in regular traffic lanes from Grand Canyon Dr. to Rainbow Blvd., from Arville St. to Koval Ln. and from Boulder Hwy. to Jimmy Durante Blvd. Improvements include resurfacing and restriping approximately 7 miles of Flamingo Road, the installation of 100 new transit shelters, intersection and traffic signal upgrades, the installation of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) technologies to improve traffic flow, non-irrigated landscaped medians, and improved pedestrian crosswalks.

GES is utilizing Bowling Mamola, Inc. as a certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprise to provide at least 4.7% of GES' services for this project.

GES is currently providing materials testing and observation services, as well as inspection services, which includes qualified personnel to perform sampling, testing and observation services during soils, aggregates, concrete, and asphalt construction. As part of the GES team, Bowling Mamola, a certified Disadvantaged Business, is evaluating testing frequencies for both QA and QC scopes and prepares a summary for the monthly reporting.
